Community Housing

Community Housing provides low rent housing to people with lower incomes.

Tenants pay rent based on a percentage of their income as defined by the Social Housing Accommodation Regulation.



Community Housing

A subsidized housing program where your rent is geared to your income. Capital Region Housing is the landlord for the Community Housing Program.

The Program

CRH offers a variety of apartments and townhouses, as well as studio to five bedroom units.

A security deposit is required and rent is based on the household's income; applicants are assessed by priority for this program.

Income is also reviewed on an annual basis and may be adjusted if the household income changes.

All household members must be eligible as defined by the Social Housing Accommodation.

Crime Free Multi Housing Program

CRH partners with the Edmonton Police Service to bring the Crime Free Multi- Housing Program to all our properties. The program is designed to make our apartments and townhouse complexes a more secure and safer environment for tenants.

Applicants must complete an application and submit it either in person, by mail or by fax to the CRH office.
